Tabby:

BLUE-SILVER TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color pale bluish silver. Markings sound blue. Undercoat white. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. **Nose leather**: blue or old rose trimmed with blue. **Paw pads**: blue or old rose. **Eye color**: green, hazel, gold or copper.

BLUE-SILVER PATCHED TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color pale bluish silver. Markings sound blue. Patches of cream or softly intermingled areas of cream on both body and extremities. Undercoat white. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. **Nose leather**: blue or old rose trimmed with blue and/or pink. **Paw pads**: blue or old rose and/or pink. **Eye color**: green, hazel, gold or copper.

RED SILVER TABBY (Red Silver Tabby) (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color off-white. Markings red. Undercoat white. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. **Nose leather and paw pads**: pink. **Eye color**: gold or copper.

CREAM SILVER TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color off white. Markings cream. Undercoat white. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. **Nose leather and paw pads**: pink. **Eye color**: green, hazel, gold or copper.

Calico and Bi-Color:

BI-COLOR: black and white, blue and white, red and white, or cream and white, blue-silver and white, red silver and white, cream silver and white, shaded and white, or chinchilla and white. As a preferred minimum, the cat should have some white on the feet, legs, undersides, chest and muzzle. Less white then this should be penalized proportionately. Symmetry of those markings, no matter the amount of color vs. white, is desired. White blaze desirable. Eye color: green/blue-green; gold to copper, as appropriate to base color description; or odd-eyed.

VAN BI-COLOR: black and white, blue and white, red and white, and cream and white, blue-silver and white, red silver and white, cream silver and white, shaded and white, or chinchilla and white. White cat with color confined to the extremities: head, tail, and legs. One or two small colored patches on body allowable. Eye color: green/blue-green; gold to copper as appropriate to base color description; or odd eye. Nose leather and paw pads: to conform to the already established solid requirements; nose leather and paw pads may also be pink.

SMOKE AND WHITE: black smoke and white, blue smoke and white, red smoke and white, cream smoke and white, tortie smoke and white, blue-cream smoke and white. White with colored portions, the colored portions of the cat to conform to these currently established smoke color standards.

TABBY AND WHITE (all patterns, including patched): silver tabby and white, brown tabby and white, red tabby and white, blue tabby and white, cream tabby and white, blue-silver tabby and white, red-silver tabby and white, cream-silver tabby and white. White with colored portions, the colored portions of the cat to conform to the currently established tabby color descriptions.

LILAC: rich, warm lavender with a pinkish tone, sound and even throughout. **Nose leather and paw pads**: lavender-pink. **Eye color**: gold or copper.

Silver and Golden

CHOCOLATE SILVER: undercoat white with a mantle of chocolate tipping. Rims of eyes, lips and nose outlined with chocolate. Nose leather: brown. Paw pads: cinnamon-pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

LILAC SILVER: undercoat white with a mantle of lavender tipping. Rims of eyes, lips and nose outlined with lavender. Nose leather: lavender-pink. Paw pads: lavender-pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

TORTOISESHELL <u>AND CHOCOLATE TORTOISESHELL</u> SILVER: the undercoat is pure white; back, flanks, head, ears and tail tipped with black <u>or chocolate</u> and red (light and dark shades) harmoniously distributed in tortoiseshell pattern. **Eye and nose rims**: outlined in black, pink, or patched with both. **Nose leather**: black, <u>cinnamon pink</u>, pink, or patched with both. **Paw pads**: black, <u>cinnamon pink</u>, pink, or patched with both. **Eye color**: gold or copper.

BLUE-CREAM AND LILAC-CREAM SILVER: the undercoat is pure white; back, flanks, head, ears and tail tipped with blue-grey or lilac and cream (light and dark shades) harmoniously distributed in tortoiseshell pattern. Eye and nose rims: outlined in blue-grey, lilac, pink or patched with both. Nose leather: blue-grey, lavender-pink, pink or patched with both. Paw pads: blue-grey, lavender-pink, pink or patched with both. Eye color: gold or copper.

CHOCOLATE GOLDEN: undercoat ivory to pale honey or apricot with a mantle of chocolate tipping. Rims of eyes, lips and nose outlined with chocolate. Nose leather: brown. Paw pads: cinnamon-pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

LILAC GOLDEN: undercoat ivory to pale honey or apricot with a mantle of lilac tipping. Rims of eyes, lips and nose outlined with lilac. Nose leather: lilac-pink. Paw pads: lilac-pink. Eye Color: gold or copper.

TORTOISESHELL SILVER: chocolate, the undercoat is pure white; back, flanks, head, ears and tail tipped with black and red (light and dark shades) harmoniously distributed in tortoiseshell pattern. **Eye and nose rims**: outlined in black, pink, or patched with both. **Nose leather**: black, pink, or patched with both. **Paw pads**: black, pink, or patched with both. **Eye color**: gold or copper.

TORTOISESHELL, AND BLUE-CREAM, CHOCOLATE TORTOISESHELL AND LILAC-CREAM GOLDEN: the undercoat is ivory to neutral beige; back, flanks, head, ears and tail tipped with the appropriate base color (Black and Red; Blue and Cream; Chocolate and Red or Lilac and Cream) mottled or patched with areas of red, shades of red or cream. Eye and

nose rims: outlined in base color, pink, or patched with both. **Nose leather**: appropriate to base color and/or pink. **Paw pads**: appropriate to base color and/or pink. **Eye color**: gold or copper.

Smoke/Shaded

SMOKE COLORS: Black Smoke, Blue Smoke, Red Smoke, Cream Smoke, Tortoiseshell Smoke, Blue-Cream Smoke, chocolate smoke, chocolate tortoiseshell smoke, chocolate calico smoke, lilac smoke, lilac-cream smoke, lilac calico smoke.

Tabby

CHOCOLATE TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color milk chocolate. Tabby markings a deep, dark chocolate affording sufficient contrast with ground color. Lips and chin the same shade as around the eyes. Nose leather: brown and/or brick red. Paw pads: brick red to cinnamon pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

CHOCOLATE PATCHED TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): milk chocolate ground color marked with darker chocolate tabby markings and patches or softly intermingled areas of red. Lips and chin the same color as rings around the eyes. Nose leather: brown, brick red and/or cinnamon pink. Paw pads: brick red, cinnamon pink and/or coral pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

CHOCOLATE SILVER TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color milk chocolate, undercoat white. Tabby markings a deep, dark chocolate affording sufficient contrast with ground color. Lips and chin the same shade as around the eyes. Nose leather: brick red. Paw pads: brick red to cinnamon pink. Eye color: green, hazel, gold or copper,

CHOCOLATE SILVER PATCHED TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): milk chocolate ground color marked with darker chocolate tabby markings and patches or softly intermingled areas of red, undercoat white. Lips and chin the same color as rings around the eyes. Nose leather: brick red to cinnamon pink. Paw pads: brick red, cinnamon pink and/or coral pink. Eye color: green, hazel, gold or copper.

LILAC TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color pale frosty lavender with a pinkish patina, marked with darker lavender tabby markings affording sufficient contrast with ground color. Nose leather: lavender. Paw pads: pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

LILAC PATCHED TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color pale frosty lavender with pinkish patina, marked with darker lavender tabby markings and patches or softly intermingled areas of cream. Lips and chin the same color as rings around the eyes. Nose leather: lavender and/or pink. Paw pads: lavender pink and/or pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

LILAC SILVER TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color pale frosty lavender with a pinkish patina, marked with darker lavender tabby markings affording sufficient contrast with ground color, undercoat white. Nose leather: pink. Paw pads: pink. Eye color: green, hazel, gold or copper.

LILAC SILVER PATCHED TABBY (classic, mackerel, spotted): ground color pale frosty lavender with pinkish patina, marked with darker lavender tabby markings and patches or softly intermingled areas of cream, undercoat white. Lips and chin the same color as rings around the

eyes. **Nose leather**: pink. **Paw pads**: lavender pink and/or pink. **Eye color**: green, hazel, gold or copper.

Parti-Color

Move Blue-Cream color description to follow the tortoise color description.

CHOCOLATE TORTOISESHELL: rich, warm chocolate brown with patches of red or softly intermingled areas of red on both body and extremities. The presence of several shades of red acceptable. Nose leather: brown, brick red and/or pink. Paw pads: brick red, cinnamon pink and/or pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

LILAC-CREAM: rich, warm pinkish toned lavender with patches of cream or softly intermingled areas of cream on both body and extremities. Nose leather: lavender, lavender pink and/or pink. Paw pads: lavender pink and/or pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

Tabby

Move existing tabby and white descriptions to the Calico/Bi-Color Section; if previous proposals pass, consolidate these in a similar fashion (i.e., list the color/pattern, don't describe fully).

CHOCOLATE CALICO: a tri-color cat of chocolate, red and white. The red and the chocolate should appear as clear, unbrindled patches. As a preferred minimum, the cat should have white feet, legs, undersides, chest, and muzzle. Less white than this minimum should be penalized proportionately. As a preferred minimum, the cat should have a colored tail and one or more colored patches on the head and/or body. Less color than this minimum should be penalized proportionately. Eye color: gold or copper, or odd-eyed.

LILAC CALICO: a tri-color cat of lilac, cream and white. The cream and the lilac should appear as clear, unbrindled patches. As a preferred minimum, the cat should have white feet, legs, undersides, chest, and muzzle. Less white than this minimum should be penalized proportionately. As a preferred minimum, the cat should have a colored tail and one or more colored patches on the head and/or body. Less color than this minimum should be penalized proportionately. Eye color: gold or copper, or odd-eyed.

CHOCOLATE PATCHED TABBY AND WHITE (classic, mackerel, spotted): same as chocolate patched tabby with the addition of white. Blaze desirable. Nose leather: brown, brick red and/or cinnamon pink. Paw pads: brick red, cinnamon pink and/or coral pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

CHOCOLATE SILVER PATCHED TABBY AND WHITE (classic, mackerel, spotted): same as chocolate silver patched tabby with the addition of white. Blaze desirable. Nose leather: brick red to cinnamon pink. Paw pads: brick red, cinnamon pink and/or coral pink. Eye color: green, hazel, gold or copper.

LILAC PATCHED TABBY AND WHITE (classic, mackerel, spotted): same as lilac patched tabby with the addition of white. Blaze desirable. Nose leather: lavender and/or pink. Paw pads: lavender pink and/or pink. Eye color: gold or copper.

LILAC SILVER PATCHED TABBY AND WHITE (classic, mackerel, spotted): same as lilac silver patched tabby with the addition of white. Blaze desirable. Nose leather: pink. Paw pads: lavender pink and/or pink. Eye color: green, hazel, gold or copper.

BI-COLOR: black and white, blue and white, red and white, or cream and white, chocolate and white, or lilac and white, smoke and white, shaded and white chinchilla and white. As a preferred minimum, the cat should have some white on the feet, legs, undersides, chest and muzzle. Less white then than this should be penalized proportionately. Symmetry of those markings, no matter the amount of color vs. white, is desired. White blaze desirable. **Eye color**: gold to copper or odd eye.

VAN BI-COLOR: black and white, blue and white, red and white, and cream and white, chocolate and white, or lilac and white, smoke and white, shaded and white chinchilla and white. White cat with color confined to the extremities: head, tail, and legs. One or two small colored patches on body allowable. Eye color: gold to copper or odd eye. Nose leather and paw pads: to conform to the already established solid requirements; nose leather and paw pads may also be pink.

SMOKE AND WHITE: White with colored portions, the colored portions of the cat to conform to these currently established smoke color standards, black smoke and white, blue smoke and white, red smoke and white, cream smoke and white, chocolate smoke and white, lilac smoke and white, tortie smoke and white, chocolate tortie smoke and white, blue cream smoke and white, lilac cream smoke and white.

^{*}Any cat submitted for Registration Via Pedigree that contains the pointed pattern in the first five generations must include documentation that the cat has been microchipped for identification purposes and submit a DNA test proving the cat does not carry einnamon, fawn or the pointed pattern in order to be registered. All such cats will be assigned the regular BCS code for the cat's color and a notation will be made in the cat's record that a DNA test has been received confirming the cat does not include einnamon, fawn and/or the pointed pattern, in its five-generation pedigree.

RATIONALE: Cinnamon and fawn have been recognized and worked with in many different respected registries. Our own judges have handled these cats while judging all over the world. If

we, as a breed, want to expand the gene pool, keep our breed healthy and work in conjunction with our fellow breeders from around the world we need to accept these colors for registration.
