1. **PROPOSED:** Revise the NOSE description to address nostrils:

NOSE: short, snub, and broad, with "break" centered between the eyes. <u>Nostrils (nares)</u> sufficiently open to allow cat to breathe without restriction.

**RATIONALE:** In conversations with Persian breeders over the years, most have spoken to the size of the nostrils being large or open as part of what ethical and responsible breeders work for in their program. Many even believed it was already part of the standard. As it was not, it is fitting to add something breeders have already been working toward for years as it is in the best interest for the health of the breed.

**2. PROPOSED:** Update the DISQUALIFY section to include nose leather too high:

**DISQUALIFY**: locket or button. Kinked or abnormal tail. Incorrect number of toes. Any apparent weakness in the hind quarters. Any apparent deformity of the spine. Deformity of the skull resulting in an asymmetrical face and/or head. Nose that is visibly set to one side of the vertical centerline of the face. Crossed eyes. Nose leather that is above the top line of a fully opened eye. \*
