Per CFA Rules; All entries must be made ONLINE via https://ecat.cfa.org/login?

The Seaside Civic & Convention Center show hall is Heated or Air Conditioned as needed. The show hall is accessible. It is a NON-smoking facility. NO Alcohol is allowed in the convention center. Entries are limited to 225. Per CFA Rules; Entries close Monday, December 29th at 8:59 pm Pacific time or when 225 entries have been received.

**Hotel Information:** There is no official "show hotel" this year. EBB-Tide Inn (503-738-8371), Hi-Tide Inn (503-738-8414), The Rivertide Suites and others typically offer winter discount rates.

Recommended Airport: Show Hall is approx. 1 hour 50 minutes from the Portland OR Int'l Airport (PDX)

Show Rules: The show will be conducted in accordance with current CFA show rules. These may be obtained online at https://cfa.org/wp-content/uploads/2025/04/25-26show-rules.pdf or send \$7.00 plus \$2.00 postage to CFA, 260 East Main Street, Alliance, OH 4460. All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Rosettes and Ribbons will be awarded according to CFA show rules. No kitten under the age of four months will be allowed in the show hall. Blue slips may be required for proof of age.

Entries: Per CFA rules, all entries must be submitted via the main CFA eCats entry portal at https://ecat.cfa.org/login? CFA rules state that entry fees must be paid within 10 days after receiving enty confirmation or by the start of the show. Whichever is first. There will be a \$25.00 late fee charged if payment is not made or postmarked on or before January 3rd. Make checks or money orders payable to Emerald Cat Club. Cash or Credit card payment can be made at the door. Paypal is available at Emeraldcatclub@gmail.com

**Health:** No veterinary inspection will be required prior to benching. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be current on all vaccinations (FVRCP, FeLV, Rabbies, ect). Oregon State Law requires current Rabies vaccination. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Front and back claws must be clipped before benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for entry. All cats are expected to be free of fleas, mites and infectious Illneses. Show Management reserves the right to have any cat showing signs of illness, or parasites removed from the show hall.

**Household Pets:** Household pets are eligible only for awards in the Household Pet Class. Household pets are to be judged separately from all other cats, solely on beauty and condition. Wild cats or wild cat-domestic hybrid crosses are not eligible for entry. All Household Pets eight (8) months of age or older must be spayed or neutered.

Cages: A single Bench space of  $21'' \times 21'' \times 21''$  is provided with each entry. A double bench space is  $42'' \times 21'' \times 21''$ . You may purchase a double bench space for a single entry @\$20. No more than one adult or two kittens per single bench space. Per state law, No grooming tables can be placed in the aisles. Please bring your own cage. A limited number of wire cages will be available for \$10.00 / cage. Wire cages require a double bench space.

**Check-In & Show Hours:** Check-in time will be 8:30 to 9:30 am. Show hours are from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm on Saturday, 9:00 am to 4:00 on Sunday. PLEASE HELP US GET THE SHOW DONE BY 4:00 PM. One benching request per exhibitor will be honored whenever possible. No benching changes are permitted without the permission of the show manager.

**Food & Litter:** Litter will be provided. Cat food as donated. Please bring your cat's preferred food as well as dishes and litter pans. People Food available for purchase in the show hall 10 am to 2 pm daily.

EMERALD CAT CLUB WILL FOLLOW ALL City, County, State and Federal Covid-19 and Related Health and Safety Mandates, Restrictions and Guidlines in the planning and production of this show. CFA Best Practices for Clubs and Participants will also be followed. These are subject to change as current conditions and situations require.
